

**\*\*City of Toronto Hotel Data: Week of July 04, 2020**

As can be observed by the summary table below, occupancy is down by 84.1% compared to this week last year, ADR is down by 35.3%, RevPar is down by 89.7% and room nights sold are down by 86.6%. The supply is down by 15.9%. Preliminary YTD through July 04, 2020 sees occupancy down by 54.6%, ADR down by 13.7%, RevPar down by 60.8% and room nights sold down by 60.1%.
