As can be observed by the summary table below, occupancy is down by 86.8% compared to this week last year, ADR is down by 52.7%, RevPar is down by 93.8% and room nights sold are down by 89.5%. The supply is down by 20.2%. Preliminary YTD through June 20, 2020 sees occupancy down by 52.6%, ADR down by 13.0%, RevPar down by 58.7% and room nights sold down by 58.3%.
