

**\*\*City of Toronto Hotel Data: Week of June 27, 2020**

As can be observed by the summary table below, occupancy is down by 85.3% compared to this week last year, ADR is down by 45.5%, RevPar is down by 92.0% and room nights sold are down by 88.0%. The supply is down by 18.5%. Preliminary YTD through June 27, 2020 sees occupancy down by 54.0%, ADR down by 13.8%, RevPar down by 60.3% and room nights sold down by 59.6%.
