As can be observed by the summary table below, occupancy is down by 88.8% compared to this week last year, ADR is down by 51.1%, RevPar is down by 94.5% and room nights sold are down by 91.0%. The supply is down by 19.8%. Preliminary YTD through June 6, 2020 sees occupancy down by 47.7%, ADR down by 9.7%, RevPar down by 52.8% and room nights sold down by 53.2%.
