

**\*\*City of Toronto Hotel Data: Week of May 16, 2020**

As can be observed by the summary table below, occupancy is down by 89.6% compared to this week last year, ADR is down by 51.6%, RevPar is down by 95.0% and room nights sold are down by 91.7%. The supply is down by 19.6%. Preliminary YTD through May 16, 2020 sees occupancy down by 43.2%, ADR down by 7.5%, RevPar down by 47.5% and room nights sold down by 48.4%.
