As can be observed by the summary table below, occupancy is down by 88.8% compared to this week last year, ADR is down by 51.4%, RevPar is down by 94.5% and room nights sold are down by 91.0%. The supply is down by 19.9%. Preliminary YTD through May 23, 2020 sees occupancy down by 45.3%, ADR down by 8.4%, RevPar down by 49.9% and room nights sold down by 50.6%.
