

****City of Toronto Hotel Data: Week of January 16, 2021**

As can be observed by the summary table below, occupancy is down by 78.2% compared to this week last year, ADR is down by 41.2%, RevPar is down by 87.2% and room nights sold are down by 80.9%. The supply is down by 12.3%. Preliminary YTD through January 16, 2021 sees occupancy down by 72.2%, ADR down by 37.4%, RevPar down by 82.6% and room nights sold down by 75.7%.
