

**\*\*City of Toronto Hotel Data: Week of January 23, 2021**

As can be observed by the summary table below, occupancy is down by 78.0% compared to this week last year, ADR is down by 42.0%, RevPar is down by 87.3% and room nights sold are down by 80.7%. The supply is down by 12.3%. Preliminary YTD through January 23, 2021 sees occupancy down by 74.8%, ADR down by 39.4%, RevPar down by 84.8% and room nights sold down by 77.9%.
