

****City of Toronto Hotel Data: Week of January 30, 2021**

As can be observed by the summary table below, occupancy is down by 78.7% compared to this week last year, ADR is down by 45.5%, RevPar is down by 88.4% and room nights sold are down by 81.3%. The supply is down by 12.3%. Preliminary YTD through January 30, 2021 sees occupancy down by 75.7%, ADR down by 40.9%, RevPar down by 85.6% and room nights sold down by 78.7%.
